**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-37  
AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES  
FOR THE FUEL TANK REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Council authorized a contract with Apex Companies for the replacement of the fuel tank system for \$229,277.50; and

WHEREAS, during the project, several conditions were identified that resulted in change orders, increasing the cost of the project by \$108,508 for additional excavation and shoring and removal of contaminated soils; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department was advised to update the fueling software to better function with the new pumps and fuel dispensing equipment at a cost of \$13,251.45.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to pay additional expenditures of One Hundred Twenty-One Thousand, Seven Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars (\$121,762) to Apex Companies.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
