

An Interim Library

The City is securing an interim location to provide continuity of the Library and Computer Center's essential services.

Timeline:

- 8/24, 8pm: Closure of the original site
- 8/25-10/2: No Library services will be available during this time
- 8/25-9/6: Packing the contents of the Library and Computer Center
- 9/7-9/15: The Actual Move
- 10/3 (expected): Opening of the Interim Library and Computer Center

Location:

- Site selected within Takoma Park
- Subscribe to the City's Insider e-newsletter, follow us on social media, or visit the City's website for the most current information



An Interim Library

Hours:

- We intend to keep our current hours at the interim location:
- Monday Thursday, 10am-8pm
- Friday Sunday, 12pm-6pm

What services will be in the interim location?

- Checking out and returning books and all other materials
- Books to Go curbside service
- Computer access and assistance
- Wi-Fi access and limited reading/work spaces



Returning Books during the Interim

At the Interim Library:

- We will be able to accept books during operating hours
- We will not have a 24/7 returns option at the Interim Library

At the Community Center (7500 Maple Ave):

 The outdoor, 24/7 book drop will be available in front of the Police Station Lobby at 7500 Maple Avenue, after we reopen

Please do not return books during the closure, as we will not have a way to check them in.

If you have extenuating circumstances, such as moving away from the area, please email us so we can work with you to arrange for the books' return.

Anticipated Work Schedule*

Date(s)	Activity
August 24, 2022	At the end of regular hours (8pm), the Library and Computer Center will close temporarily to pack and move to the interim location
September 7, 2022	Movers will arrive to transport Library and Computer Center materials to the temporary location
September 19, 2022	Work begins to prepare the site of the new building
October 3, 2022	Expected date that the Library and Computer Center will reopen in the temporary location
October - December 2022	Library building will be taken down and the site prepared for new construction
Fall 2023	Recreation Offices and Staff will move to join the Library and Computer Center Staff at the Interim Library location - Renovation of the Recreation spaces at 7500 Maple Avenue begins
Spring 2024	Construction is completed and the new facilities open!

Site Work and Preparation

Preparing the site for the new Library will include the following:

- Removal and storage of the Library mosaic so that it can be reinstalled later
- Tree removal and repurposing
- Utilities and parking lot closures



Services at the Community Center

The following services will remain at the Community Center:

- o Passport Services
- o Notary
- o Limited Recreation classes and camps
- o Limited community meeting spaces
- o City Council meetings (Hybrid format)
- o Takoma Park Police Department
- o City offices will remain open

Minimizing Disruptions during Construction

Noise Parking School Drop-off and Pick-up



Noise associated with construction may occur:

- Monday Friday,
 between 7am and
 6pm
- Saturday, between 8am and 5pm



Parking will be accessible but limited at the following locations:

- Police level
- Rear of the Community Center, close to Grant Ave
- Grant Avenue
- Follow us for updates



Staff are working with neighboring school administrations to help them coordinate drop-off and pick-up.

We will also provide regular updates so arrangements can be made to mitigate the impact on families.
