Points in review of charter and code

- Give those qualified to register with the county but not so registered the option of registering with the city. (Board agreed on this change idea 3/9/2018.)
- Eliminate provisions for voting by released felons. (Board agreed on this change idea 3/9/2018.)
- Make charter consistent with city's use of a single Takoma-Park-only registration list. (Board agreed on this change idea 3/9/2018.)
- Define "in line at poll closing time" for side-by-side elections (where there are two lines). (Board agreed to this change idea 3/9/2018.)
- Yard sign authority requirement?
- Electioneering (poll watcher garb, advocacy for non-city candidates)?
- Harmonization with county (for side-by-side elections)? (Focus on election-day polling place activity.)
- Clear guidance on "distinguishing marks" on ballots?
- Consistent use of "Elections Board" or "Board of Elections" in code and charter (both are currently used)?
- Prohibit contributions by foreign nationals? (Federal ban said to apply to city elections.)
- Make charter consistent with practice of board (rather than "judges of the election") certifying the final result? Make practice consistent with charter?
- Clarity on residence requirements and moving between wards?
- Clarity on whether college students can register as Takoma-Park-only voters?

Generally: avoid incorporation of county, state, or national law by reference (so that candidates and others can use city law as a single source of information).
