Tracy Rezvani – gave a presentation on various types of scams and frauds used to deceive people. Included were home improvement, disaster contractors, charities, and other types. Persons should always ask for licenses and references when getting work done. Contractors are entitled to 1/3 of the cost up front for a project, be careful of overcharging, for charities check the websites: Guidestar and Charity Navigator for information on a charity being legitimate.
