 - --working with County on June 14 outreach project re 'help until help arrives';
 - --will be looking at County EOP for application to Takoma Park;

 - --working on high rise building outreach + information on drug take back, and other preparedness// end June-September 2018.
- School security (Ron Hardy and by phone with Michael Harting of MoCo School Safety):
 - --high schools have a School Resource Officer, and secondary schools (6-12th grades) have security teams; all schools have cluster security coordinators. The Maryland Safe to Learn Act 2018, will require every school to perform active shooter drills, along with the others (evacuation, fire, lockdown, etc) by Fall 2019.
