Topics shared and discussed:

--City/ County updates (Ron Hardy):

- City of Takoma Park is asking Montgomery County for personal protective equipment (ppe)
- Takoma Park web page has updated corona virus information "Information and resources covid-19" : takomaparkmd.gov→ search, corona virus
- Washington Adventist Hospital/ Takoma park will be installing 63 beds for covid-19 patients: date not clear yet
- Mask donations needed for high rise building tenants: please leave masks in the police dept entrance (lower level)
- Pepco warns us that scammers are again threatening to cut power if money isn't provided → Pepco points out that they will NOT cut power during the covid-I9 crisis even if people do owe money

--Community issues

- Young folks closely congregating/hanging out together: several members shared this information and that it was difficult to get the group to separate and move on+ noise issue
- Sligo Creek Parkway: only about 1/3 seem to be wearing masks, including families; since Sligo is fairly narrow in sections, need to be extra careful and move away.
- Food support: Manna and Adventist Church are distributing food; Takoma Park Middle School 'Difference Makers' are also distributing food.
