 - shared recovery survey issues: concerns re transportation, resources
 - covid-19: pre-registration for 75 and over via county → not coordinated with hospitals, pharmacies, others. # info: 240-777-2982;
 - Montgomery County only gets 30% of available vaccines from the state!
- -Guest: Kathleen Bartels, Montgomery County Vaccine Hunters
 - Formed due to terrible problems finding vaccines: no internet, no phone #s available; complicated process via tech site, etc.
 - Mo Co has *** no single site for signing up→8 MoCo teachers—4 speak English; 4 speak Spanish.—purpose to help especially elderly get vaccine appointments.

 - Since vaccine amount very limited, the Vaccine Hunters are focusing on working with varied groups to get more and set up easy access/understanding of process in several languages
