## TREE COMMISSION MEETING

## Wednesday, February 9, 2022 7:00 PM – on Zoom

## **MEETING MINUTES**

**ATTENDEES:** Meipo Martin, Ward 2; Paul Obrien, Ward 4; Bart Sheard, Ward 3; Xavier Blake Sparrow, Ward 3; Gorky Villa, Ward 2; James Woodworth, Ward 2; Marty Frye, Urban Forest Manager

- 1. Approval of Meeting Minutes for November meeting (Jim Woodworth)
  - Approved minutes submitted to Jessie Carpenter 2/10/2022.
- 2. Public Comments none.
- 3. Urban Forest Manager report (Marty Frye)
  - Street tree pruning is under-way this winter ( $\sim 1/2$  per week
    - Under supervision of new staffer, Anna Misch John, Vegetation Maintenance Supervisor
    - Prioritizing areas of traffic conflict with low-hanging branches for clearance of busses, garbage trucks, etc.
    - Multi-year effort during winter months
    - Unlikely that this would be a future volunteer opportunity (e.g. Citizen Pruners) because of staff capacity to oversee, liability, safety, quality control
  - Pilot planting effort underway per Council directive
    - Targeted planting effort focused in Ward 6, multi-family residential/apartment/condo; commercial; institutional
    - Outreach underway for 'free trees' to be planted this spring
    - Target of ~10 trees
    - Q: can TP partake as a city in Tree Montgomery (or Forest Montgomery, or other programs)?
    - A: MF has an email inquiry in to POC
    - In contrast to 'bulk buy'/'Plant A Tree' program which is partially subsidized
      - Of note: accepting requests for spring 'Plant A Tree' program through Feb 21<sup>st</sup> for spring 2022.
      - As volume of tree plantings were to increase, question of staff capacity being stretched too thin
      - DPW contemplating an RFP for its own city tree-fund funded planting program; which would include consultation by landscape professional and planting
      - Sparked conversation about role of Tree Commission in Education and Outreach; after some discussion it was suggested that more time was

warranted for this topic and that it should be a formal agenda item for a future meeting; it was agreed to add to agenda for next meeting.

- Arbor Day
  - Foregoing an in-person bare-root seedling giveaway
  - Seedlings often end up dead
  - Considering a future containerized tree giveway
  - Instead, considering a zoom webinar of a tree-related theme
    - If you have ideas to contribute for consideration, feel free to reach out to Marty
- 4. Discussion of detailed talking points presented to City Council, Mayor and Public Works Director during meeting on Sept 14, 2021. (Bart Sheard)
  - Reoccurring themes/issues noticed over multiple hearings
    - Compliance with TC decisions
    - Communications between TC and DPW/attorney
    - Integrity of hearing process
      - Commitments made during hearings under oath
        - Either not carried out/followed through
        - Or uncertainty if carried out or not
        - E.g. status of required replantings
        - E.g. commitments made by developer to engage neighbors on stormwater issues; did not occur prior to develop proceeding
        - Concern about perjury, making mockery of appeals and hearing process
  - Commission felt it was our responsibility to raise issues to Council
  - Council responsibility to act or not
  - Marty pointed out that its often the case that projects are drawn out and ongoing
    - Montgomery College is still under construction
    - It would not be useful to replant until construction activities have concluded
  - Commission to request follow-up meeting with city attorney to seek clarification about boundaries of commission hearings, decisions, follow-up discussions
- 5. Discussion of changes to Commission by-laws. (Bart Sheard)
  - Discrepancy/misalignment between individual commissioner appointment durations, and terms for officers
    - TP FY is July 1 June 30; Officer terms are Oct 1 Sept 30
    - Commissioners have staggered term lengths:
      - June 2022
      - June 2023
      - June 2024
    - Bart will send an email articulating the problem and possible solutions
  - Monthly meeting has changed from second Tuesday of month to second Wednesday of month
    - Motion to amend by-laws to change meeting day to second Wednesday passed.
