Work Session

Discussion of Legislative Action Requests for Submission to the Maryland Municipal League

Recommended Council Action

Discuss and decide on three requests to put forward for consideration by the Maryland Municipal League (MML) Legislative Committee.

Context With Key Issues

Each year, MML determines its legislative priorities based on Legislative Action Requests (LARs) submitted by Maryland municipalities and MML chapters and departments, and on priority issues not resolved from the prior session. The LARs are reviewed by MML staff and provided to the MML Legislative Committee for consideration. The Legislative Committee selects up to four issues to be recommended to the MML membership at the fall conference. A resolution approving submission of LARs is scheduled for July 6, 2016.

Successful LARs should have broad applicability and benefit to Maryland municipalities rather than just Takoma Park or Montgomery County. To date, the following items have been suggested for consideration in the work session discussion:

- Legislation to hold utilities accountable for removal of old wires and to require coordination between SHA and utilities to reduce destruction and repair of newly or recently paved municipal roadways and sidewalks (2015 request). Pursuant to the language included in the final State of Maryland budget, SHA will provide a report by Nov. 1, 2016.
- Work to ensure that municipal residents are no longer harmed by tax duplication laws or the lack of appropriate tax duplication laws, and that reimbursement or tax differential eligibility is extended to all tax-duplicated services regardless of how those services are funded by the municipality or county (2015 request).
- Pursue the creation of an Innovation Fund from which municipalities could receive grant funding to undertake efforts in support of State of Maryland priorities (2015 request).
- Collection of video from police body-worn cameras and Maryland Public Information Act implications (Councilmember Smith).
- Request an evaluation of the collection and distribution of business personal property tax by the State of Maryland (City Manager's suggestion).
