Single Reading Ordinance Authorizing the Purchase of IT Server Equipment, Software and Installation

Recommended Council Action

Approve ordinance for purchase of IT server equipment, software and installation

Context with Key Issues

The FY 2017 Equipment Replacement Reserve included \$64,000 to replace and upgrade IT servers that have reached the end of their useful lives. The project involves completion of the consolidation of servers into the City's existing VMware environment. These servers are used by Public Works, the Library, Police Department, and the Information Systems Division.

More specifically, the project includes replacement of our storage array with 21 TBs of enterprise grade storage, repurposing our existing network access storage system as a backup, installing and configuring new VMware host memory, installing and configuring new backup and replication software, and establishing new file servers and configuring them for central management.

City Code 7.08.070 (D) states that competitive bidding is not required when "one available source for the good, service or construction item or if a specific manufacturer's product is required to ensure compatibility with existing installed equipment." A company called InfoSys installed our existing VMware equipment and configured the system and environment, and proceeding with InfoSys will ensure compatibility as we complete the work they started. Also, the company that developed the storage array equipment (Nimble Storage) will only issue a single quote per client, regardless of the vendor through which it is being purchased. We can purchase this piece of equipment through InfoSys for \$29,280, whereas the quote we received through a vendor who has the same equipment for sale from their inventory was \$68,221. For these reasons, InfoSys is approved as a sole source provider.

Based on the scope of work, the total cost of the equipment and work is expected to be \$48,966.98.
