Second Reading Ordinance Appointing Judges and Workers for the November 7, 2017 City Election

Recommended Council Action

Adopt the ordinance as amended.

Context with Key Issues

Pursuant to Section 607 of the City Charter, the City Council appoints judges for the election. Board of Elections members serve as judges and also recommend other individuals to work during the election.

Election workers and judges are paid for their service as follows:

Election Day – Full Day	\$240.00
Election Day – One Shift	\$115.00
Election Day – Closers and Counters	\$ 45.00
Early Voting – Per Day	\$ 90.00

First reading of the ordinance was held on October 18, 2017. Since first reading, the ordinance has been revised to include additional election workers.
