Resolution Providing for Appointments to the Takoma Park Youth Council

Recommended Council Action

Adopt the resolution.

Context with Key Issues

The City Council established the Takoma Park Youth Council:

- To provide an opportunity for the youth of Takoma Park to acquire a greater knowledge of and appreciation for local government through active participation in the system.
- To help the City Council to address problems and accomplish the goals of this community by working directly with the representatives of youth.
- To serve the youth of Takoma Park by:
 - o informing the Takoma Park municipal government of the needs and wishes of youth;
 - planning and implementing social, educational, cultural and recreational activities for the youth;
 - working with the Mayor, City Council, City department heads, schools, civic clubs and service organizations to provide service and leadership opportunities for the youth of the City; and,
 - o helping to instill a feeling of positive self-worth and esteem, teaching respect for the rights of others, and promoting community pride.

The Youth Council is to be comprised of nine members from grades 7 through 12, representing a cross-section of the City's youth. At least one member, but no more than two, will be appointed from each ward. Three members will be appointed at large.

The City Council solicited applications from Takoma Park young people in grades 7-12. After review, the Council selected nine of the applicants for appointment.
