SUPPORTING ARBOR DAY 2018 IN TAKOMA PARK

- **WHEREAS,** trees are an important part of the character of Takoma Park and provide many benefits to residents, such as improving air quality, reducing the need for air conditioning, serving as windbreaks, stabilizing soils, providing watershed protection, and providing wildlife cover and food; and
- **WHEREAS,** cities play a vital role in promoting and encouraging the protection and planting of trees and other environmentally sound practices; and
- WHEREAS, the Urban Forest Division of the Department of Public Works, in coordination with the Takoma Park Tree Commission and other interested residents, has organized an Arbor Day celebration and tree giveaway; and
- WHEREAS, this event is designed for the local community to participate in Arbor Day activities; and
- WHEREAS, Arbor Day will be celebrated on Saturday, April 7, 2017, outside the Takoma Park Maryland Library from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.; and
- **WHEREAS,** the activities will include educational opportunities and the distribution of free tree seedlings; and
- WHEREAS, the Takoma Park Tree Commission will be on hand to answer questions.
