Resolution Providing for an Appointment to the Safe Roadways Committee

Recommended Council Action

Adopt the resolution as part of the consent agenda.

Context with Key Issues

The City Council re-established the Safe Roadways Committee in 2012 to serve in an official advisory and coordination role to the City Council on all matters related to transportation, including, but not limited to, pedestrian and bicycle facilities and safety, traffic issues, and transit services. The Committee is to have up to 11 residents appointed to two-year staggered terms. Members may not serve more than six years continuously.

Due to changes in Committee leadership and declining membership, the Committee has been inactive in the past year. The two remaining members, Frank Demarais (Ward 5) and Michael Moore (Ward 6) have expressed a willingness to work with the Council to consider how best to structure the Committee to make it sustainable and able to continue to fulfill its advisory role.

Ms. Jessica Landman (Ward 1) has applied to serve on the Committee and has expressed interest in participating in the discussions about reorganizing it.
