Context with Key Issues

The City of Takoma Park is an active member in the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG). Founded in 1957, COG is an independent, nonprofit association, with a membership of 300 elected officials from 24 local governments, the Maryland and Virginia state legislatures, and U.S. Congress. COG is supported by financial contributions from its member governments, federal and state grants and contracts, and donations from foundations and the private sector. COG's work engages leaders in various environmental fields from water quality experts to urban foresters. COG dues are based on member population. FY 2019 Dues for Takoma Park: \$13,360. The City benefits from grant opportunities provided through COG.
