Resolution Providing for an Appointment to the Takoma Park Ethics Commission

Recommended Council Action

Adopt the resolution as part of the consent agenda.

Context with Key Issues

The Takoma Park Ethics Commission is composed of up to seven members appointed by the City Council. The responsibilities of the Commission are: (1) to devise, receive and maintain all forms generated by the Ethics Ordinance; (2) to provide advisory opinions to persons subject to the Ordinance; (3) to hear and decide any inquiry or complaint regarding an alleged violation of the Ethics Ordinance; (4) to conduct a public information program regarding the purposes and application of the Ordinance; (5) to recommend legislative changes and improvements to the Ordinance; and (6) to promulgate regulations to accompany the Ordinance.

Commissioners are appointed to staggered two-year terms. Current members are: Arthur Gary (Ward 6), Ellen Maidman-Tanner (Ward 2), Patricia Anne Murphy (Ward 2), Nicholas Rozek (Ward 4) and Michael W. Richards (Ward 1). There are two vacancies on the Commission.

Jess Bravin (Ward 3) has applied for appointment. The application was provided to the City Council for review.
