Resolution Providing for Reappointments to the Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee

Recommended Council Action

Adopt the resolution as part of the consent agenda.

Context with Key Issues

The Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee oversees implementation of and adherence to the Takoma Park Nuclear Free Zone Act and provides public information on issues related to the Act. There are two vacancies on the seven-member Committee and two members whose terms expired on March 31. Members with expired terms are: Julie Boddy (Ward 1) and Paul Gunter (Ward 1). Ms. Boddy and Mr. Gunter have applied for reappointment to the Committee. All applications have been provided to the Council for review and consideration.

Also serving on the Committee are Reid Baron (Ward 3), Dave Lanar (Ward 1) and Jay Levy (Ward 1).
