Resolution Providing for an Appointment to the Noise Control Board

Recommended Council Action

Adopt the resolution.

Context with Key Issues

The Noise Control Board was established to assist and advise the City on noise control issues, including administration and enforcement, and to adjudicate two-party noise disturbance complaints. The Board consists of five to seven members appointed by the City Council. Members serve staggered three-year terms. Terms expire on March 31 of the term year.

Serving on the Board are: Anne Perrault (Ward 3), Ashley Files Flory (Ward 1), Rani Parker (Ward 3), and Clifford Schwartz (Ward 2). There are three vacancies.

Merlene Mazyck, resident of Ward 6, has applied for appointment. The Council has reviewed her application and desires to appoint her.

**RESOLUTION 2019-
PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE NOISE CONTROL BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Noise Control Board was established by Takoma Park Code, Chapter 14.12, to adjudicate two-party noise disturbance complaints and assist and advise the City on noise control issues, including administration and enforcement of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the two-party noise disturbance complaint process in the ordinance relies on an active Noise Control Board to adjudicate these noise disturbance complaints; and

WHEREAS, the Board is to be comprised of five to seven active members appointed to staggered three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, there are three vacancies on the Board; and

WHEREAS, Merlene Mazyck, resident of Ward 6, has applied for reappointment; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Takoma Park, Maryland that Merlene Mazyck, Ward 6 resident, is appointed to the Noise Control Board for a term to expire on March 31, 2022.
