The Committee on the Environment advises the City Council on environmental issues and serves in partnership with the City Council and Takoma Park City staff to achieve sustainability and other environmental goals. Serving on the Committee are John Ackerly (Ward 2), Jeffrey Brokaw (Ward 2), Sharon Cohen (Ward 3), Hellen Gelband (Ward 3), Kopal Jha (Ward 2), Geoffrey Short (Ward 4), Andrew Silton (Ward 1), Denis Borum (Ward 6), Elizabeth Thompson (Ward 3), Kirsten Stade (Ward 4), and Seth Grimes (Ward 1). There are four vacancies on the Committee and one member serving a term that expired on June 30.

Jeffrey Brokaw (Ward 2) was serving a term that expired on June 30, 2019. He has applied for reappointment. There are two new applicants for appointment: Michael Feldman-Weincek (Ward 3) and Colleen Cordes (Ward 1). The Council has reviewed the applications.
