




Status of Council-Appointed Committees


- 16 standing committees with occasional short-term committees
- 143 members currently serving
- 30 current vacancies on committees or 17 percent
- Largest committees: Recreation, Committee on the Environment,
 Arts and Humanities 15 members each
- Smallest committee: Tree Commission 5 members









Committee Survey Results

Areas for Future Discussion/Consideration

Council Role and Oversight

- Periodic review of purpose and scope of work of committees
- Committees "adopted" by Council members who serve as liaisons
- Annual or bi-annual meetings between Council and committee chairs

Areas for Future Discussion/Consideration

Recruitment, Appointments and Diversity

- Recruitment/nominating committees of 2 or 3 Council members
- Clarify role of Council, staff and committee members in recruitment
- Possible process for vetting potential members
- Services that may enable more people to participate



Areas for Future Discussion/Consideration

Committee Operations

- Orientation for committee members
- Training for committee officers
- Common structure for all standing committees
