- COVID 9 Response and Financial and Staffing Impacts
 - Assistance to residents and businesses
 - Monitoring financial impacts
 - Staff and services



- City Manager Recruitment
 - Select executive search firm
 - Interview candidates; assistance by firm and HR
 - Select by June
- Heaviest work by Council in December, May and June
- Staff preparation for transition through June

Takoma Junction Redevelopment Project



- Revised plans submitted to Montgomery County
- City staff are beginning the review, with focus on criteria of Council Resolution and Development Agreement
- Clause by clause analysis will be prepared and shared with public in late December for review and comment
- Heaviest work by Council in January and February; then Planning Board action

- Minor Master Plancovers area of WAH, WAU, Maple Ave to Community Center
 - MNCPPC to undertake beginning in January; wants MOU on process with City
 - WAU has development partner for WAH property; but zoning is only for singlemily homes so really can't act until Minor Master Plan completed
 - Involves significant public process; mostly-istatifisive at first

- Other development review work
 - Likely to be projects coming before Council, including one on New Hampshire Avenue, one at JNA site
 - Likely to be staffitensive difficult to schedule
- Recreation Center project visioning report in March
- Public Space planning
- Thrive Montgomery 205@efore the Planning Board now

- Council Priority Setting
 - Retreats to be held in January
 - Priorities to be set for 202022 term.
 - Provides budget and work plan direction to staff; important for incoming City Manager
- Heaviest work by Council in January

- Library Project
 - Presentation to Council on Dec 2
 - Review environmental/other options and consider costs
 - Provides direction for going out to bid
- Consideration by Council in December and when bids come in
- Staff will need to coordinate relocation of books and services for time of construction
- Interviews for new Library Director first week of December



- Legislation and Lobbying
 - Local hearings already being held on State legislation
 - Hearings on bills early this year due to pandemic constraints
- Heavy work by Council now through March; also involves a number of staff and our lobbyist
- A number of major issues affect Takoma Park

- Reimagining Public Safety Task Force
 - Reviewing proposals for facilitation services now; choice of firm on Dec 2nd
 - Council to appoint task force members in January
- Heavy staff work on assembly of data, records, policies
- Council to consider interim recommendations in April and receive report in June

- Finalize new stormwater fee system
 - Educate residents on proposal and how it may affect them; requires significant staff work
 - Council to consider Code changes and new system in February so in advance of budget consideration
- Finalize Tree Ordinance regulations and process
- Next steps on climate change response




- Budget preparation and consideration
 - Heavy staff work January through March to prepare proposed budget; hard to do while also providing direct service during pandemic
 - Council consideration will be April and May
- In January, will review "hold" list, fiscal situation
- Property tax credit options to be discussed

- Council Boards, Committees and Commissions
 - Council to consider processes, evaluate committees, make appointments by June
 - Staff to establish violation reporting system
- Some quagiudicial actions are on hold while court actions are restricted due to pandemic

- Pandemic could hold more surprises, as could weather impacts due to climate change
- May need to prep for assistance with vaccinations
- Still considering what to do with some City services, particularly child care and fivaccess
- Funds are needed for residents, businesses, local governments needs to be a federal priority


