

PROPOSED AMENDMENT ON ADAPTATION AND RESILIENCE

Councilmember Kovar

Amend the 10<sup>th</sup> Resolved Clause as follows:

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City will continue its work on, and explore additional options for, priority local actions and strategies aimed at increasing the community's ability to adapt and be resilient to climate change, through such steps as the following:

- continuing the City's commitment to protection and healthy growth of the urban forest and tree canopy, tree protection and plantings, for for both climate mitigation and resilience, as part of the City's efforts to amend the expressed in Tree Ordinance amendments and the resolution on and establish urban forest policies and tree canopy goals and principles;
- improved stormwater management for both public space and stormwater flows on and between private properties;
- efforts identified in the Public Space Management Plan process that also address adaptation and mitigation;
- greenhouse gas capture and sequestration;
- supporting community-led adaptation and mitigation efforts, as feasible; and
- strengthened emergency preparedness plans and activities, including potential human health risks from extreme heat and other weather conditions; and

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In the 10<sup>th</sup> Resolved clause add the following new bullet point:

“investigating technologies and practices that promote more efficient management of energy use, storage and generation”

DRAFT TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO CLIMATE RESOLUTION (MARCH 2, 2020 VERSION)

Line 87: Change “fossil-free energy” to “fossil fuel-free energy”

Line 173: Insert “p” at the beginning of “policies”

Line 258: Change “resident” to “residential”
