Resolution Providing for an Appointment to the Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee

Recommended Council Action

Context with Key Issues

The Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee oversees implementation of and adherence to the Takoma Park Nuclear Free Zone Act and provides public information on issues related to the Act. There are three vacancies on the seven-member Committee. Linda Gunter, resident of Ward 1, has applied for appointment to the Committee. The application has been provided to the Council for review and consideration. Also serving on the Committee are Paul Gunter (Ward 1), Julie Boddy (Ward 1), Dave Lanar (Ward 1) and Jay Levy (Ward 1).

Environmental Considerations

A purpose of the City's Nuclear Free Zone Act is to protect residents, visitors, and the environment from the harmful effects of highly radioactive nuclear waste that results from research, production, and deployment of nuclear weapons and the production of nuclear energy. Appointment of members to the Committee helps to ensure that it can continue its service in support of the Council's environmental goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Takoma Park, Maryland hereby appoints Linda Gunter, Ward 1 resident, to serve on the Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee to a term that will expire on March 31, 2021.
