Context with Key Issues

Lunch and Learn will organize a virtual summer meals and enrichment program that provides young people, ages 6-16, an opportunity to receive meals, enrichment and leisure activities from June 22 to July 31, 2020. Recognizing the value of the summer program for the community and the challenges of fundraising to maintain the activities, the City Council has included \$45,000 in the FY 2021 budget by way of the Community Partnership Program to support Lunch and Learn.

An agreement has been prepared setting forth the terms of the contract and providing for disbursement of the funds. The draft ordinance authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement.
