Two Reading Ordinance Approving the Request of the Committee on the Environment to Suspend Its Operations

Recommended Council Action

Approve Ordinance at Second Reading

Context with Key Issues

The City Council has received a request from the Committee on the Environment to suspend its operations. The request also seeks to permit the members of the Committee on the Environment to continue their individual work with a racial justice facilitator. The City Attorney has prepared a draft Ordinance to approve the request. The Ordinance will expire on June 30, 2021.

Several changes were made to the draft Ordinance text at First Reading, as shown on the attached draft.

Council Priority

Environmentally Sustainable Community; Engaged, Responsive, Service-oriented Government

Environmental Considerations

Suspension of the Committee eliminates the assistance of the group as a whole to offer recommendations on environmental matters to the City Council.

Fiscal Considerations

There is no fiscal impact of this action.

Racial Equity Considerations

A main purpose of the suspension is to allow for Committee members to work with a racial justice facilitator and to allow time for the City Council to appoint a more racially diverse membership.

The Committee on the Environment shall suspend its operations effective upon the passage of this Ordinance. 37 38 39 Section 2. The current members of the Committee on the Environment, John Ackerly, 40 Jeffrey Brokaw, Kirsten Stade, and Elizabeth Thompson, may continue their 41 individual work with a racial justice facilitator. 42 43 Section 3. The Committee on the Environment may resume operations as directed by the 44 City Council, as set forth in Section 4. 45

Section 4. The City Council may rescind, modify, or extend this uncodified emergency 1 2 Ordinance. 3 4 Section 5.
