Ann Ciekot of Public Policy Partners will provide an update on legislative activities already underway for the Maryland General Assembly Legislative Session that formally begins in January. This year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the proposed bills will be discussed earlier in the Session. As Ms. Ciekot will share, the Session has very different operating procedures for this year, which will affect how we pursue legislation in the City's interest.
