The Grants Review Committee serves in an official advisory role to the City Council, providing recommendations on the award of grant funds available through the City's Community Grants program. Up to nine residents, with demonstrated expertise in community development, grants management, public arts, or related areas of interest, may serve on the Committee for a maximum of two consecutive three-year terms.

There are currently five vacancies on the Grants Review Committee. Takoma Park residents Keli Cochran (Ward 6), and Mark Swartz (Ward 1) have applied for appointment. Currently serving on the Committee are Nadine Bloch (Ward 3), Rachel Branaman (Ward 6), Susan Rosenblum (Ward 3), and Nicole Ferraiolo (Ward 1).
