Resolution Authorizing the Extension of Emergency Regulations Concerning Noxious Growths, Undesirable Trees, and Fees

Context with Key Issues

Ordinance 2020-22, effective October 27, 2020, amended certain provisions of Chapter 12 of the City Code of Takoma Park regarding trees and vegetation. With City elections affecting the City Council meeting schedule, it was necessary for the City Manager to approve interim regulations on an emergency basis pursuant to Section 2.12.100(B) of the City Code, so that regulations were in place while draft administrative regulations were going through the public notice process. The process of considering comments on draft administrative regulations requires publication in the Takoma Park Newsletter soliciting such comments, review of the comments, publication of final regulations in the Newsletter and then, ten days after publication, the regulations become effective. This process could not be completed within the 60 days allowed under Section 2.12.100(B). The City Manager is requesting that the City Council extend the interim regulations for 30 additional days while the administrative regulation process concludes.

Dear Councilmembers,

As you know, we have been going through the draft administrative regulation process related to tree-related fees and noxious growth regulations. While that has been happening, I had adopted the regulations as interim regulations so that we could have regulations that worked with the revised Tree Ordinance. The timing of publishing the draft regulations in the Newsletter to solicit public comments meant that the draft regulation process could not be finalized within 60 days and another 30 days is needed. I am required to provide a written request for an extension; a draft Resolution for that 30 day extension has been added to tonight's Council agenda. The text of the notice is below and a copy of the draft resolution is attached.

The amendments to Chapter 12 require that certain administrative regulations be established.

Pursuant to section 2.12.100(B), the City Manager approved on an emergency basis two regulations relating to noxious growths, undesirable trees, and fees in order to have the regulations in effect while the proposed regulations in question went through the comment and notification process required by the City Code.

The emergency regulations went into effect on October 28, 2020, and will remain in effect for a period of sixty days.

Additional time is required to complete the regulation process set forth in section 2.12.050.

Several provisions of Chapter 12 that expressly reference administrative regulations will be without effect if the effective period of the emergency regulations is not extended beyond sixty (60) days.
