## Proposed Amendment Regarding Adding an Additional Pre-election Campaign Finance Report and Adjusting the Time for Filing the Pre-election Campaign Finance Reports. 7/28/20

## **5.12.022** Campaign Finance Reports.

A. Each candidate or their authorized representative and each authorized representative of any political committee shall file reports with the City Clerk disclosing all contributions and all disbursements in accordance with this section.

B. Each candidate and political committee, or the authorized representative of each candidate or political committee, shall file the following reports:

1. A post-nomination report, which shall be filed no later than 4:00 p.m. of the third Monday after the City nominating caucus;

2. A <u>first pre-election report</u>, which shall be filed no later than 4:00 p.m. <del>of</del> <u>on the fourth</u> <u>Monday preceding election day</u> <del>at least seven days preceding the start of early voting</del>;</del>

3. <u>A second pre-election report, which shall be filed no later than 4:00 p.m. on the second</u> <u>Monday preceding election day:</u>

43. A post-election report, which shall be filed no later than 4:00 p.m. of the Monday following the election;

54. An annual report, which shall be filed no later than January 31st of each year, on the retention or disposition of surplus campaign funds until all such funds are used or distributed; and

The post-nomination report shall include all information required to be reported by this section from the date of the preceding election or the most recent annual report, if applicable, up to and including the full day before the filing of the post-nomination report. All other reports shall include information starting from the full day that the previous report was filed up to and including the full day before the filing of the current report.
