Takoma Park Minor Master Plan Amendment Process

- Comprehensive Review, but of a smaller Plan Area
- Same process in a compressed timeline
 - City Council
 - Planning Board
 - County Council
- Defined Scope of Work
- Focused public engagement



Why this Plan is Important

- State Law requires a comprehensive review through the master plan process before any zoning changes are made
- To assess the future needs of the Washington Adventist Hospital Campus and the Surrounding Community
- Plan will provide goals and recommendations for any future development
- Open and Transparent Process

Equity In Planning

The Montgomery County Racial Equity and Social Justice Act, which the County Council signed into law in December 2019 to actively address racial disparities within the county, requires the Planning Board to consider racial equity and social justice impacts when preparing a Master Plan. Pursuant thereto, all Plan process elements will be implemented with the lens of equity.

Partnership – MOU Roles

- The Planning Department is the Lead Agency in the administration, engagement, development, quality assurance, and production of all deliverables for the Plan through all phases of the planning process.
- The City will provide support and collaborate in the engagement, development, quality assurance, and production of all deliverables for the Plan.
- Planning and City staff will brief the City Council at key milestones prior to briefing the Planning Board
- Planning staff and City of Takoma Park staff will coordinate regularly during ongoing project coordination meetings (biweekly)
