Single Reading Ordinance Authorizing Purchase of a Replacement Loader

Recommended Council Action

Approve the ordinance.

Context with Key Issues

The Fiscal Year 2022 budget includes funding for the purchase of a replacement loader. The Department has selected a manufacturer of this equipment and identified an intergovernmental cooperative purchase agreement through Sourcewell that we can participate on for the purchase.

The loader selected is a John Deere, Model 544 and is distributed by Jesco Inc. The Sourcewell price for this equipment includes a 41% discount from list price, bringing the cost of the purchase to \$175,113. Additionally, the vendor will purchase the old loader for trade in value of \$44,000. This brings the effective cost of the purchase to \$131,113.

The current loader was purchased in 2007 and has exceeded its expected life.

Environmental Considerations

This equipment will be used to perform certain projects related to maintenance, snow removal, vehicle loading and unloading. The equipment uses diesel fuel and the City uses an environmentally preferred blend of bio-diesel which is 20% soy oil and 80% diesel fuel.

Fiscal Considerations

This purchase will be made through the Equipment Replacement Reserve and funds are available within the reserve to cover the cost of the equipment.

Racial Equity Considerations

The purchase and use of this equipment will not adversely affect or disproportionately impact any particular group.

AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF A LOADER
