Resolution Approving Submission of 2024 Legislative Action Requests to the Maryland Municipal League

Recommended Council Action

Adopt the resolution.

Context with Key Issues

The City Council may submit up to three requests for consideration as MML priorities for the 2024 Legislative Session. The requests should have broad benefit or appeal to municipalities in Maryland in order to be considered as MML priorities.

The deadline to submit MML Legislative Action Requests for the 2024 Session is Friday, June 30. The requests must be endorsed by adoption of a City Council resolution.

Mayor Searcy prepared a draft resolution for Council review on June 14. She will be updating the resolution based on the discussion that evening.

The MML Legislative Committee will select ideas from among all municipal submissions and prepare up to four to be voted on by League members at the Fall Conference in October.

Council Priority

All: Advancing a Community of Belonging; Fiscally Sustainable Government; Environmentally Sustainable Community; Engaged, Responsive, Service-Oriented Government; Community Development for an Improved & Equitable Quality of Life

Environmental Considerations

The Council considers environmental and sustainability goals when determining legislative priorities.

Fiscal Considerations

The Council considers the City's fiscal health and the promotion of opportunities for revenue generation when determining legislative priorities.

Racial Equity Considerations

The Council considers racial equity when determining its legislative priorities.
