Context with Key Issues

During the Takoma Park Minor Master Plan review, Council identified the intention to hold a work session with Montgomery County Public Schools staff in Resolution 2023-33:

Be It Further Resolved that during the development of the Planning Board Draft Plan, the City Council will endeavor to hold work sessions on the following topics related to the MMPA:

• School facilities within the MMPA area and the Montgomery County Public School (MCPS) site selection and school construction process."

MCPS staff has been invited to present to Council about this topic as well as enrollment projections and plans to upgrade Piney Branch Elementary School.

Representatives from Montgomery County Public Schools, Seth Adams and Adrienne Karamihas will present to Council and be available for questions.
