Recommended Council Action

Review and adopt the Resolution Establishing the FY26 Budget Calendar

Context with Key Issues

Following the second FY26 Budget Calendar work session last week, staff drafted the attached resolution. The only change to the budget calendar itself from the September 25th meeting is the removal of the candidate orientation, and the public survey launch date was pushed back two days to October 16th to allow for some additional feedback on the draft survey and translation services.

Council Priorities

Advancing a Community of Belonging; Fiscally Sustainable Government; Environmentally Sustainable Community; Engaged, Responsive, Service-Oriented Government; Community Development for an Improved and Equitable Quality of Life.

Environmental Considerations

RESOLUTION 2024-___ Resolution Adopting the FY2026 Budget Calendar

- WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the FY24 budget schedule, the City Council passed Resolution 2023-15 establishing certain policy objectives associated with the subsequent fiscal year's budget; and
- WHEREAS, as part of that resolution, the Council formed a budget work group that evaluated "relevant budgetary practices of Maryland municipal structures for inclusion in the City budgetary preparations"; and
- WHEREAS, following several months of research and meetings with City staff, in September, 2023, the work group presented a draft proposed budget calendar for FY25 that was later adopted by the Council; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to continue its annual adoption of a fiscal year budget calendar to ensure steady pacing and adequate time for the City Manager and their staff to develop the budget while also including opportunities for public engagement, fiscal forecasting, budget orientation/onboarding to newly elected councilmembers, and the formalized adoption of council budget priories; and,
- WHEREAS, at the September 18 and 25, 2024 regular City Council meetings, the City Council held work sessions on a proposed draft FY26 budget calendar.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Takoma Park, MD, hereby adopts the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget Schedule, attached hereto as Attachment A.
