Reported that it had been found expedient to make
 new arrangements for lighting the street lamps
 owing to the resignation of Mr. Miller and that the
 Committee had contracted with Mr. Tom Jones to take
 care of all the lamps in town at a compensation
 of \$20.⁰⁰ per month and a guarantee of 4 days
 work on the streets, a saving of \$500 per month
 from rate previously paid.
