- WHEREAS, this year, we honor the memory of Staff Sergeant Adam S. Thomas, killed in Nangarhar Province, Afghanistan on October 4, 2016; and
- **WHEREAS,** Sergeant Thomas lived in Takoma Park and worked as an environmental activist between graduating college and enlisting in the U.S. Army in 2008; and
- WHEREAS, we honor the memory of Sergeant Jonathan Cadavero, a 2004 graduate of Columbia Union College, killed in Baghdad, Iraq in 2007; and
- **WHEREAS,** as we celebrate and honor our veterans this year, we will also remember our duty to work for peace and justice and an end to violence throughout the world.
