National Voter Registration Day – September 22, 2020

WHEREAS,	National Voter Registration Day is a nonpartisan civic holiday encouraging voter registration and celebrating our democracy; and
WHEREAS,	the day is celebrated on the fourth Tuesday in September each year; and
WHEREAS,	National Voter Registration day typically involves a coordinated voter registration effort by volunteers across the country; and
WHEREAS,	the saturation of national and local media helps to raise awareness of voter registration opportunities and encourages civic participation; and
WHEREAS,	because of the cancellation of most community events due to the pandemic, there have been fewer in person opportunities to promote voter registration, making it more important than ever promote registration on this special day in 2020.
NOW, THEREFORE, I, KATE STEWART, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, hereby proclaim and recognize September 22, 2020 as Voter Registration Day and encourage every eligible resident to register or confirm their registration so they can prepare to vote by mail on in person in the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election and the City of Takoma Park
