**CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND
ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 19**

**PURCHASE OF PLANTERS FOR MAPLE AVENUE
COMMUNITY GARDEN PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2010, the Council endorsed the installation of a community garden in partnership with M-NCPPC and Franklin Associates, on the parking area of 7620 Maple Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Equinox Industries/Alfa Products, Inc. has provided a quote in the amount of \$11,350 for the purchase and delivery of 28 above-ground self-watering planters, required to establish the community garden as proposed; and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that Equinox Industries/Alfa Products, Inc. is the sole source supplier of this equipment and, consequently, the purchase meets the criterion of a sole source procurement, and

WHEREAS, the FY2010 Special Revenue Fund's CDBG Maple Avenue project includes sufficient funding for the proposed purchase.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council has reviewed and accepted the City Manager's determination that the purchase of the planters from Equinox Industries/Alfa Products, Inc. meets the criterion for a sole source procurement.

SECTION 2. The quote submitted by Equinox Industries/Alfa Products, Inc. in the amount of \$11,350 is accepted.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
