**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-4
AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR
PAVEMENT CONDITION EVALUATION**

WHEREAS, a component of the City's program for maintaining street pavement is the evaluation of surface conditions; and

WHEREAS, the last street study was concluded in 2003 and has served as the basis for scheduling resurfacing projects since then; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated options for the next survey of City streets and recommends that the City hire a firm to perform an automated survey using digital technology; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Information Solutions is a Maryland-based company that can provide this survey; and

WHEREAS, the City of Virginia Beach, Virginia has awarded a competitively bid contract to Enterprise Information Solutions for these services; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the pavement survey, evaluation, ranking, software, and training will be \$26,889.48; and

WHEREAS, funding for the study is available in the Public Works Department budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to enter into a contract with Enterprise Information Solutions for said pavement evaluation services.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
