**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-24  
REPLACEMENT OF BOILER FOR PUBLIC WORKS**

WHEREAS, the boiler in the Public Works Facility has exceeded its useful life and many components of the system are not working adequately; and

WHEREAS, the proposed boiler replacement will include installation of an energy efficient unit to provide heating to those sections of the facility that are not included in the current renovation project; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City procurement procedures, the Public Works Department solicited bids for the boiler replacement; and

WHEREAS, four proposals were received, with the lowest bid submitted by Summer/Winter Automation; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Summer/Winter Automation has been determined to be responsive and responsible; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Equipment Replacement Reserve to award a contract for the replacement of the boiler.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to enter into a contract with Summer/Winter Automation for replacement of the boiler in the amount of \$64,585.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
