ORDINANCE NO. 2011-43

**AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES
ON HILLTOP ROAD**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Takoma Park Code, Section 13.28.010, the Director of Public Works is authorized to place, erect, and maintain upon the public highways of the City such traffic calming devices as the Council may direct at locations designated by the Council or as determined by the City Manager or his or her designee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

1. A raised intersection will be installed near the intersection of Hilltop Road and Mississippi Avenue;
2. A raised crosswalk will be installed across Hilltop Road to the south of Geneva Avenue;
3. A speed hump or chicanes may be installed on Hilltop Road between Geneva Avenue and Maple Avenue; and,
4. The exact location, type, and number of each device shall be determined by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee.
