**CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND**

**ORDINANCE 2011-45  
AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A SECURITY ACCESS SYSTEM FOR THE  
PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY**

WHEREAS, the Public Works Facility renovation project is nearing completion; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Keller Brothers, Inc. included installation of wiring for electronic door and gate access; and

WHEREAS, purchase and installation of the associated equipment and software are the responsibility of the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed security access system would add proximity card readers on both entry gates to the Public Works Facility and to key entry doors in the various buildings comprising the Facility;

WHEREAS, the proposed system is similar to that currently in use at other City facilities and is compatible with the staff identification cards already issued; and

WHEREAS, staff obtained pricing for the project from three qualified vendors;

WHEREAS, the lowest price was provided by Innovative Security Systems; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends contracting with the Innovative Security Systems for completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the project is \$16,863.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract in the amount of \$16,863 with Innovative Security Systems for the purchase of equipment, software, and installation for a security access system;

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
