**CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND
ORDINANCE NO. 2013-13**

**AWARD OF CONTRACT
FOR IRRIGATION SYSTEM INSTALLATION SERVICE FOR LEE JORDAN FIELD**

WHEREAS, the irrigation system for Lee Jordan Field is in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, funding for installation of a new irrigation system for the field is included in the FY 2013 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Department issued a Request for Bids for these services on February 21, 2013; and

WHEREAS, only the bid of Brickman was fully responsive to the scope of services provided; and

WHEREAS, the Department has been pleased with services provided by Brickman in the past and believes that selection of Brickman would be in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Department recommends awarding the irrigation system installation contract to Brickman; and

WHEREAS, this project is included in the City's Program Open Space program so that 75% of the project cost will come from Program Open Space funding and 25% of the cost will come from the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

SECTION 1. The Acting City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Brickman to provide an irrigation system installation service in an amount not to exceed \$28,960.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
