**CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND
ORDINANCE NO. 2014-9**

**AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION
OF A REPLACEMENT PHONE SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2014 budget includes \$120,000 for the purchase and installation of a Phone System; and

WHEREAS, the Information Systems Department solicited bids from qualified vendors through a Request for Proposal process; and

WHEREAS, of the two responses received, the Information Systems Manager recommends acceptance of the proposal submitted by Clear Connection, Inc. in the amount of \$81,924.43; and

WHEREAS, the Information Systems Manager recommends that a contingency to accommodate possible change orders be authorized in the amount of \$25,000; and,

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds budgeted to cover the project and change order contingency cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Clear Connection, Inc. for \$81,924.43 is accepted and the City Manager or his designee is authorized to purchase the phone replacement equipment and associated hardware.

SECTION 2. To accommodate potential project and change order contingency costs, the City Manager or his designee is authorized to spend up to a total of 106,924.43 for the project.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
