ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR LIGHTING
UPGRADES AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER**

WHEREAS, in accordance with City procurement procedures, the Public Works Department solicited price proposals for retrofitting certain existing light fixtures with light emitting diode (LED) fixtures at the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, four firms submitted bids for the project; and

WHEREAS, Elysian Energy submitted the lowest bid; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has determined that the lowest bidder is both responsive and responsible; and

WHEREAS, The City received a grant from the Maryland Energy Administration Smart Energy Communities for \$58,376; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds were used for procuring an energy audit and HVAC repairs, leaving a balance of \$26,678; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department requests permission to award a Not to Exceed Contract of Twenty-Six Thousand, Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$26,678) to Elysian Energy to complete a portion of the lighting upgrade.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into a contract with Elysian Energy for retrofitting existing light fixtures at the Community Center.

Section 2. This contract is not to exceed \$26,678.

Section 3. This Ordinance becomes effective upon adoption.
