**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-17**

**REPEALING ORDINANCE 2014-2 FOR HVAC EQUIPMENT REPAIR  
IN THE COMMUNITY CENTER**

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2014, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 2014-2, awarding a contract to Summer Winter Automation for completing repairs to HVAC components in the Community Center including several Roof Top Units, Air Handling Units and Exhaust Fans; and

WHEREAS, the City was subsequently notified by the Maryland Energy Administration that they would no longer allow grant funds to be used for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No 2014-2 must be repealed as the Department does not intend to fund this work through the operating budget in this fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance No 2014-2 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Ordinance becomes effective upon adoption.
