**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-19
AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR LIGHTING UPGRADES
AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER**

WHEREAS, in accordance with the City's procurement procedures, the Public Works Department solicited price proposals for retrofitting certain existing light fixtures with light emitting diode (LED) fixtures at the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, four firms submitted bids for the project; and

WHEREAS, Elysian Energy submitted the lowest bid for \$35,475; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized a contract for Elysian Energy to complete Phase 1 of the lighting retrofit for \$26,678 by Ordinance 2014-10 on February 10, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Department now requests authorization for Elysian Energy to complete Phase 2 of the lighting retrofit at a cost of \$8,797.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into a contract with Elysian Energy for Phase 2 of the light fixture retrofit at the Community Center.

Section 2. This contract amount is Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Seven (\$8,797) Dollars.

Section 2. This Ordinance becomes effective upon adoption.
