

**CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2015-17  
AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE FOR  
FLOWER AVENUE STREET LIGHT CONVERSION**

- WHEREAS, the City's FY 15 budget includes funding in the Special Revenue Budget to upgrade existing street lights to LED fixtures along Flower Avenue; and
- WHEREAS, the source of the funding is Community Development Block Grant funds; and
- WHEREAS, Pepco owns said street lights and provides upgrade services for a set fee; and
- WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that Pepco is a sole source provider of the services; and
- WHEREAS, the replacement of existing street lights with LED fixtures will reduce energy use, maintenance charges, and provide for a better quality of light, and
- WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Special Revenue Budget to cover the anticipated cost of these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

- SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to pay Pepco \$77,549 to provide for the conversion of existing streetlights on Flower.
- SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
