ORDINANCE NO. 2017-41

MAKING A NEW UNITED PEOPLE (M.A.N.U.P) – TEEN AND YOUNG ADULT MENTORING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park City Council's vision for Takoma Park, as set forth in its Council priorities, is for the advancement of a sustainable and livable community with an engaged, responsive and service-oriented government; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that to achieve this vision, it must work in partnership with city residents, community organizations, non-profits, the business community, and other governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council included \$100,000 in the FY 2018 budget to support the Community Partnership program of which \$20,000 will be awarded to Making a New United People (M.A.N.U.P), a service providing a mentoring program to Takoma Park's teens and young adults.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a contract agreement with Making a New United People (M.A.N.U.P.) for disbursement of up to \$20,000 for the 2018 Teen and Young Adult Mentoring program.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
