**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-4**

**APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CALMING  
ON THE 7900 BLOCK OF GLENSIDE DRIVE**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Takoma Park Code, Section 13.28.010, the Director of Public Works is authorized to place, erect, and maintain upon the public highways of the City such traffic calming devices as the Council may direct at locations designated by the Council or as determined by the City Manager or his or her designee; and

WHEREAS, residents of the 7900 Block of Glenside Drive initiated a traffic calming request for installation of traffic calming on the block in a process that included a petition, community meeting, and a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT:

Section 1. Removal of the existing speed hump located between 7900/7901 and installation of two new speed humps and appropriate signage at 7904/7905 Glenside Drive and 7802/7805 Glenside Drive is authorized.

Section 2: This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
